How to address Crimson Drive – leave as is, right in/right out, make it one way, make it a cul-de-sac

Having Village crews do the cul-de-sac

The cost of the construction has increase from 1.44 million to 1.88 million, creating a \$440,000 short fall. Could reduce contingency making the short fall \$220,000

The Village could apply for funding for the short fall, but will have a harder time securing. The project use to compete with rural projects, but now competes with projects like the City of Rochester

Having a meeting with Fallsview Railroad to discuss having them help fund the new bridge. State law indications that railroads are responsible for helping with bridge maintenance.

The Sanitary Sewer needs to be address in that area before the bridge project starts The Village will need to hold a Public Hearing

The bid documents and awarding the bid should be ready for October 2013

If the Village doesn't go forward with the replacement of the bridge, the State could ask for the design funds back

NYSDOT reviewed Bergmann Associates costs for the project and feel that it's actuate The next step is the Village needs to let Bergmann Associates know how they want Crimson Drive addressed and apply for the additional funding
