

# Hometown Hero Banner Program Guidelines

To honor and recognize Albion, NY servicemen and servicewomen who have served our country in the United States of America

## **Banner Information**

Each banner will be 30" by 60", double sided photo, vinyl material and **will include the following information: Name of Veteran, Branch of Service and Era of Service.** Banners will be displayed on the poles located on Main Street, Bank Street and the Avenue. Please note, only servicemen and servicewomen KIA (Killed in Action) will be displayed prior to Memorial Day.

The remaining banners will be displayed after the Strawberry Festival until Veterans Day each year – not necessarily in the same locations. The banners will be stored by the Village each year. A banner **will not** be put on display if damaged from the previous year, the sponsor of the banner may have possession of the banner if it becomes damaged. The Village of Albion cannot guarantee placement of the banners throughout the Village.

## **Application Requirements**

All Service personnel must have the following qualifications:

- Reside in Albion, NY presently or at some point of their life
- Served or is currently serving our country in one of the following: Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Marines, or Navy
- Each service person must be presently serving or be an honorably discharged Veteran, MIA, or KIA

Each banner will cost \$180.00. The price includes the double-sided vinyl banner, hardware for the hanging of the banner, and yearly storage of the banners. Any sponsor can request the return of their banner at the close of the season per year if they choose to.
