

# DPW REPORT FOR JUNE 2024

## STREETS:

- 1) Brush pickup (4) days.
- 2) Clean up after blacktopping (4) streets.
- 3) Sweep village streets in preparation for Strawberry Festival.
- 4) Put out trash receptacles downtown.
- 5) Re-stake trees on South Clinton Street.
- 6) Repair sinkhole at 227 S. Clinton.
- 7) Trim tree @322 S. Main.
- 8) Pick up and dispose of dead skunk on Rt 31 by Village House.
- 9) Cut up and remove large tree lead from John Gavenda's house. Storm damage
- 10) Grind three stumps, landscape yards.
- 11) Place millings @ shoulder of road. 112 Day St
- 12) Replace and dispose of (4) damaged American flags.
- 13) Stone driveway approaches on (4) streets that were paved.
- 14) Install shoulder material on Clarendon Rd by school.
- 15) Repair broken curb at AFD parking lot.

## PARKS AND SPECIAL EVENTS:

- 1) Mowed 18 village owned properties (4x)
- 2) Mowed approx. 14 zombie properties
- 3) Cleaned Bullard bathrooms 30 times
- 4) Watered flowers approx. 30 times
- 5) Cleaned up Bullard pavilions after 16 rentals.
- 6) Set up/ cleaned up after Strawberry Festival.
- 7) Move 10 picnic tables to new pavilion.
- 8) Went to Navarra's, picked up 16 hanging flower baskets, brought them to the village and hung up.
- 9) Installed (2) new grills at the East pavilion at Bullard.
- 10) Put up 108 military banners after taking down 30 Strawberry Festival banners.
- 11) Empty trash in parks.
- 12) Wash festival barrels and 30 foldable picnic tables and store at DPW.
- 13) Remove berm at Canal Park.
- 14) Excavate, form, pour (5) concrete pads for planters at Canal Park.
- 15) Move (5) planters from AFD to new pads in Canal Park.
- 16) Trim branches in parks.
- 17) Excavate, place fabric, stone, and tamp new parking area next to East pavilion @ Bullard.
- 18) Picked up 41 planters at Navarra's, transported to village, and set in locations downtown.

- 19) Pulled weeds, spread 100 cu/yards of wood chips in Bullard Park play areas.
- 20) Move and reset "no parking on grass" sign at Bullard.
- 21) Replant tree in Waterman Park.
- 22) Weeded concrete planters. (6 in sneezy's, 5 in canal park and 16 hanging baskets).
