

DPW REPORT FOR MAY 2024

STREETS:

- 1) Finish sidewalk plow damage restorations
- 2) Finish plow damage on dead end streets
- 3) Repair street sign at West State and West Street (tractor trailer)
- 4) Asphalt binder on streets to be paved
- 5) Reset/rebuild (7) sanitary sewer manholes for paving
- 6) Went to Henrietta to pick up sweeper from Cyncon
- 7) Remove dead tree at 357 East Ave
- 8) Continue sweeping operations
- 9) Put up American flags and fallen soldier banners
- 10) Trim trees for milling operations (clearance)
