

DPW REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 2024

STREETS:

- 1) Brush pickup (2) days.
- 2) Pick up and dispose of a dead skunk @E. State and Platt St.
- 3) Sweep village streets on 4 days.
- 4) Dig out dirt @ sidewalk 210 S. Clinton St. and replace with 5/8 ROC.
- 5) Treat weeds downtown with non-regulated weed killer.
- 6) Binder street cuts on Orchard Street.
- 7) Stripe around Fire Hall and fire hall parking lot
- 8) Stripe Behind 121 N. Main
- 9) T&L Orchard Street to prep for paving.
- 10) Stripe center line on Orchard Street.
- 11) Topsoil at Temperance and Chamberlain.
- 12) Replace stop sign @ Temperance/Chamberlain.
