

DPW REPORT FOR NOVEMBER 2024

STREETS:

- 1) Brush pickup (5) days.
- 2) Pick up and dispose of a dead deer 315 Allen Rd.
- 3) Sweep village streets on 6 days.
- 4) Leaf pickup on 11 days.
- 5) Grind stumps at 631 E. State and the corner of Beaver and Liberty.
- 6) Light pole repair on North Main St.
- 7) Take down over 100 military banners and store in the village office basement.
- 8) Check over and make repairs to Christmas decorations.
- 9) Repair lawn damage at 517 Moore St.
- 10) Install plows, wings and salters on snowplow equipment.
- 11) Put up a large Christmas tree at courthouse front lawn.
- 12) Put up Christmas banners and wreaths.
- 13) Replace timer at Christmas tree at courthouse.
- 14) Salt streets for 1st time this season.

- 1) Last day of mowing for season.
- 2) Remove scarecrows from downtown, strip down and store frames in Office basement.
- 3) Clean and winterize Bullard bathrooms.
- 4) Remove barrels from Bullard, wash and store in loft at DPW.
- 5) Push up brush and leaves at Mt Albion 3x.
- 6) Move 30 bags of concrete from Ace to Bullard storage building.
- 7) Install electric service and wire new storage shed at Bullard. (4days)
- 8) Install new shelves in Bullard storage shed.
- 9) Remove leaves from Lafayette Park and Sneezy's.
- 10) Winterize Canal Park.
