

DPW REPORT FOR MARCH 2025

STREETS:

- 1) Plowed village streets, sidewalks and parking lots 2 times
- 2) Salted streets, parking lots 1 times
- 3) Brush/leaves pickup 6 days
- 4) Dispose of dead deer
- 5) Straighten sign posts
- 6) Cold patch streets 3 day
- 7) Spring DI/Manhole survey for repairs
- 8) Stop sign reflectivity survey
- 9) Clean off downtown sidewalks for wine walk/empty trash and pick up litter
- 10) Shovel/salt sidewalks downtown (2 times)
- 11) Pick up 5 tons of cold patch at County Line Stone
- 12) Top off dig sites with dirt
- 13) Build up road shoulders with millings. Allen/E. State/Caroline/Densmore
- 14) Take down tree on S. Clinton and N. Platt St.

- 16) Scrape curb lines on all curbed village streets in prep for sweeping operations
