Hello,

My name is Michael Whiting. I am one of our many local automotive lifestyle enthusiasts. Starting in 2009, Lisa Hickein (DeCarlo,) Dan DeCarlo, and myself started putting together a car show for our area's younger car crowd called the "WNY Honda-Tech Meet." We ran this from 2009 to 2013, with the first year being held at Arnold's Auto Parts. In 2010 we moved it to Bullard Park where we would continue until 2013. On Average, we brought 125-150 cars minimum to these, and would bring people from as far as Syracuse, Ontario Canada, Pennsylvania and Ohio, with the majority being from Rochester and Buffalo. This year would be no different.

Last year you allowed us the chance to revive the car show, and it did not disappoint! We had around 110 cars, ZERO problems, awesome weather, and an awesome afternoon of great times with around 200-250 very respectful attendees. With such a great year back, we would love your consideration to do it again this year!

Our requested date is Sunday, September 21st, from 10am-3pm, with a rain date request of Sunday, September 28th, same timeframe. We always did our past Bullard events on Sundays, as not to interfere with our Village Events, and our Youth Sports Leagues (Football etc.) that usually have their events on Saturdays.

We provide our own staff, usually employees from Arnold's Auto Parts (now NAPA.) We take are of prep, taredown, and cleanup of the event personally, and have never had a complaint from the village in regards to leaving the park in a disrespectful manner afterwards. We make it very clear in our advertisements, that everyone must act in a respectful manner, both themselves and with their vehicles while attending our car show, and that we have no problems calling our local authorities if need be for violators. We make it clear in our avertisements that there will be no excessive engine revving, no loud music, and no burning out, and have had minimal to no problems with this in the past.

We are currently reaching out, and awaiting responses from possible food vendors for this years event.

Attached is a rough draft of our possible event flyer for this year, as well as site plans and detailed application information for the event. If approved, vendor info and more general information (car show rules,) will be added to the flyer before the event is advertised. In the past, our main means of advertising were Social Media, and myself handing out flyers at local car shows between Rochester, Buffalo, and Syracuse.




