

## DPW REPORT FOR JUNE 2025

### STREETS:

- 1) Swept streets on 9 days
- 2) Mill and blacktop patches on E. Bank, Platt, Sneezy's parking lot for Strawberry Fest
- 3) Brush/leaves pick up 3 days and burn brush pile
- 4) Form 40 feet of sidewalk on South Clinton Street
- 5) Pothole repair
- 6) Binder and top DPW entrance
- 7) Put out 16 hanging flower baskets and 50 planters
- 8) Cut weeds downtown and clean up for Strawberry fest
